The host hotels are within walking distance to the show grounds but if you are tired from walking all over creation looking at over 1,000 cars and trucks, you can catch a ride on one of the courtesy shuttles.

On site food vendors abound and there are a number of off site restaurants that are easily attainable within minutes of the show grounds either via your car, walking or shuttle.

However if you are one those that don't plan until the last minute, you will still be able to register the day of the show be it Friday, Saturday or if you chose, both days.

## Show Itinerary

**Friday, Cruise In - July 9, 2010 - Show Hours: 10am-11pm.  
Registration fee is \$20; or \$40 (preferred) for both days.**

You can register your car from 10:00am to 7:00pm

Friday is the Cruise-in and is open to all makes and models. There are easily over 1,000 customs, hot rods, classics, one-of-a-kind, vintage and specialty cars and trucks represented at this show. The PT's usually park close to the stage, but depending on what time you get there, depends on where you end up parking. Once your car is parked, start checking out all the cool rides parked all around you. Eye strain is expected, Visine is recommended!

### **Friday Night 7:30PM - Cruise In Concert**

You won't be bored at this show. Friday night there is a concert performed by Mike Albert and the Big"E" Band. Titled as "The Ultimate Elvis Tribute" show, Mike has become known worldwide for the respectful portrayal of the late Elvis Presley.

### **Friday Night 9:30PM Awards Presentation (6-foot trophies)**

During Mike's intermission, the 6-foot trophies will be handed out. The presentation might take a while due to the fact that there are over 100. Do PT's get them? You bet'cha! There are also 8 plus specialty awards including Best Paint, Best Engine Compartment and Best of Show.

**Saturday, July 10 is the Big Show.**

Show hours are from 12:00pm to 11pm.

Registration fee \$25 or \$40 (preferred) for both days.

If you are staying on the grounds, you can mill around from sun up to sun down (or stay out there all night). The show site is patrolled by the Dublin police department.

If you are arriving Saturday you can register from 7:30am to 11:30am. On Saturday ALL PT Cruisers will be parked together in their perspective class. We are Class 29. We are a show-within-a-show.

Judging takes place in the afternoon. You might want to stay close to your car until after it's judged. The judges could have a few questions to ask. Remember there are over 40 classes of cars & trucks to be judged.

Gail and Wil are usually pretty good at getting the awards handed out by 3:30pm (and we have a ton to hand out). Best of show cars will be participating in the parade.

Later that night . . . 7:30pm Phil Dirt & The Dozers Concert

Saturday night there is another FREE concert (included in your car registration admission price) performed by **PHIL DIRT & THE DOZERS**. . . America's premiere "Rock 'N Roll oldies" review (and the most popular vintage rock and roll show in the nation) will help you recapture those wonderful days! The **PHIL DIRT & THE DOZERS'** nostalgia show encompasses three decades of great music . . . and is performed absolutely live with a sophisticated yet light-hearted approach that creates an atmosphere all age ranges will enjoy.
